Lesotho Council of NGOs will convene public Dialogues in 10 districts of Lesotho

(23/09/16)

LCN will hold a series of public dialogues aimed at taking stock of the topical human rights issues happening in communities in all the districts of Lesotho. The dialogues will be held in all the ten (10) districts of Lesotho from 26th September to October 20th, 2016.

The objectives of the dialogues are to:

- Discuss a range of human rights problems happening at community level, district level and patterns of cases reported at
- Identify patterns of cases referred to oversight institutions including police, gender units, social development and magistrate court.
- Reflect the human rights violations patterns from community to district level
- Gather the most pressing human rights issues from the district level

Participants will include community councillors, chiefs, district government ministries, police, representatives from Correctional Services, opinion leaders and civil society organisations.

The activity is part of the Civil Society Engagement Towards Fostering Rule of Law and Accountability in Lesotho is supported by the European Union under the “European Instrument for democracy and Human Rights” (EIDHR). Under this support, LCN seeks to strengthen the capacity of local civil society organisations and other stakeholders to pursue the promotion of human rights principles, related accountability of public institutions and the democratisation process. This project, implemented by LCN also supports the drafting of shadow reports on progress made in implementing the UN Human Rights Conventions.
